Coronavirus Update

I do hope you are all keeping safe and staying home. The schools will not be reopening after Easter. We will continue to follow Welsh Government guidelines and be closed until our Local Authority tells us to reopen.

Key workers

The school will remain open for key workers and vulnerable pupils. Key workers are:

- Health workers- those employed within the NHS
- Education staff who work in schools and settings
- Emergency services- police, ambulance, fire service
- Social care workers
- Supermarket delivery drivers
- Prison officers
- Probation service staff

Only parents whose job falls into one of these categories and you have no other options for child care will be able to access this essential service.

Where possible, it is encouraged to keep your child at home to minimise social contact. However, if it is not possible you can apply to access this service at school.

Access to provision for vulnerable pupils

In addition to the children of key workers, vulnerable children are entitled to access provision. Every child who can be safely cared for at home should be and only where there is no safe alternative should provision be made in schools.

For the purpose of provision in schools vulnerable children include those with a social worker and with Statements of special educational needs. The most vulnerable of these should be prioritised according to children with most need for the provision.
