Dear parents and carers,

We are glad to be able to inform you, as things stand now, that we will continue to be able to reopen for all school pupils as originally planned **on Monday, January 10th** and after school club, Cylch and breakfast club will **continue to run as usual**.

If anything changes between now and then, we will let you know as soon as possible. As the Welsh Government have requested, plans have also been put into place should the school/classes need to move to remote learning due to staff shortages. We continue to revise our risk assessments regularly in accordance with current guidance to minimise the risk of infection.

We would like to welcome Miss Hannah Edwards to the federation team, she has been appointed to cover Miss Roscoe's class in Llanarmon whilst she is on maternity leave. Miss Roscoe is now working from home and we wish her all the very best. We look forward to hearing the news of the new addition! Miss Liz Richards, from Ysgol Cynddelw, has also had another little boy; a huge congratulations to her and the family. What lovely news! We would also like to congratulate Anti Rhonwen from Llanarmon and her family on the birth of her son. Llongyfarchiadau mawr!

We will be continuing to operate as we were before Christmas with a few changes that I have noted below following recent guidance.

Starting and finishing times reminder:

Breakfast club starts at 7.50am, Mrs Maddocks will escort pupils into Breakfast Club. From 8:40am onwards a staff member or Michelle will then escort pupils into school. Start times in the morning will remain the same, please arrive before 8.55am. Finishing time at the end of the day will continue with Mr Williams, Mrs Evans and Miss Lewis' classes finishing at 3.10pm and Miss Parkinson and Miss Evans' class finishing at 3.15pm. Nursery pupils will need to be collected at 11.30am please.

Pupils will continue to exit school via the following gates:

Mrs Evans – 3.10pm big yard gate

Miss Lewis – 3.10pm Cylch gate

Mr Williams – 3.10pm Main school entrance gate

Miss Parkinson – 3.15pm big yard gate

Miss Evans – 3.15pm big yard gate

If your child uses the 'Gamer gate' the pupils will be taken by a staff member who will unlock the gate due to the new car park parking facilities on site

In line with school guidance, we politely request that parents/carers **do not remain on the premises longer than necessary** when dropping off/collecting children. If you need to speak to your child's teacher or a member of school staff please telephone school to make an appointment or email your child's class teacher. All visitors to the school **should wear a face covering, including parents and carers when they bring their children to school and collect them at the end of the day (unless you are exempt from wearing a face covering)**. **IT IS ESSENTIAL TO CONTINUE TO WEAR A MASK ONCE YOU ARE ON THE SCHOOL PREMISES.**

Face coverings

Staff will be encouraged to wear face coverings in the school and in class when social distancing is not possible. Again, following the Welsh Government's Guidelines to schools, all visitors to the school should wear a face covering, including parents and carers when they bring their children to school and collect them at the end of the day (unless you are exempt from wearing a face covering).

Other staff such as supply teachers and teaching assistants, peripatetic teachers (instrumental lessons), specialist teachers and visitors (i.e social workers, speech and language therapists) will continue be allowed to visit the school in line with our risk assessment.



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Bubbles / Contact Groups

There will be regular handwashing and ventilation and classes will spend their time together in order to limit contacts. We will be keeping windows and outer doors open as much as possible to ensure a flow of fresh air into the classrooms while at the same time making sure that the temperature is suitable. Rooms will be well ventilated during lunchtimes and breaktimes when the pupils are not present. There are now carbon monoxide readers in each class. We will also be continuing to make as much use as possible of the outside for teaching and learning.

Pupils displaying Covid symptoms

Please **do not** send your child to school if he / she is displaying Covid symptoms in case the virus is spread. If any pupil has tested positive for Covid-19 over the Christmas holidays, could you please email the school to let us know as soon as possible.

Isolation and Testing

As I'm sure you are aware, the guidelines for isolation and testing have changed. The main changes are if an individual is identified as a close contact they will be asked to take a lateral flow test for 7 days, rather than arranging a PCR test. Additionally, the isolation period is now 7 days rather than 10, **as long as the lateral flow test on the 6th and 7th days is negative**. There is more information on the Welsh Governments website. Staff have also now been encouraged to do LFT tests 3 times a week.

Urdd Club - In light of the current situation, we will be cancelling Urdd club until further notice.

A class letter will follow shortly from your children's teachers with information regarding PE, forest school sessions etc.
